Little Owl Music & Arts Festival Poster Contest Rules

- All artwork must be turned in to Audubon Acres Visitor's Center by 5:00 pm Saturday, April 28th.
- Poster must contain an owl or an owl in a nature setting. Native owls are preferred.
- Poster can be any size and any medium may be used (crayon, marker, colored pencil, paint, etc.).
- Decisions of the judges are final.
- Prizes will be awarded the day of the Festival, May 19th.
- All artwork may be picked up after 5pm on the day of the Festival. Little Owl Music and Arts Festival will not be responsible for any artwork left after the Festival completion unless prior arrangements have been made.
- Chattanooga Audubon Society retains the rights to use duplicates of submitted artwork for future promotional purposes.
